








C136R Suction Tube





MAINTENANCE FOR 467B CLIPPER HEAD

Lubricate blades and drive parts often enough to keep blades from chattering. Use S14 Clipper Blade Lube. Turn off machine when spraying head to avoid pulling Clipper Blade Lube into suction motor. DO NOT USE WD40, OSTER CLIPPER BLADE COOLANT OR SILICONE SPRAY.

CLIPPER BLADES ARE FRAGILE AND SHARP. KEEP FINGERS AWAY FROM BLADE WHEN MACHINE IS OPERATING. ALWAYS WEAR EYE PROTECTION.

Return clipper blades to factory for sharpening and replacement of broken and worn parts. Unless otherwise requested, upper and lower cutters will be replaced if teeth are broken.

CLIPPER HEAD SERVICING (every 3 months)

Remove rocker arm, drive bushing and flexible shaft lock screw. Sleeve and drive shaft will slide out. Clean all parts including bearings inside clipper head in kerosene or its equivalent. Use C240A cleaning brush. Dry and relubricate all parts including bearings with S14 Clipper Blade Lube.

MAINTENANCE FOR CLIPPER MOTOR

Motor will stop when brushes are worn. Unscrew black cap, pull out brushes and replace with C46B10N.

MAINTENANCE FOR SUCTION MOTOR

D737 Brushes

Motor will stop when brushes are worn. Remove yellow cap and loosen screw. Pull out brushes and replace.

DF3 Filter

Change regularly (every 1-3 months). Pores of filter become clogged causing motor to overheat.
